PTA General Assembly Meeting
Tuesday, December 8, 2009

PTA President Tammy Covil called the meeting to order at 6:30 and welcomed everyone to the Winter Choral Performance.

Tammy asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the August 2009 General Assembly meeting. She reminded everyone the minutes are available online on the PTA website. Susan Garrett made a motion to approve the minutes and Ashley Harrell seconded the motion. The motion was passed.

Next, Tammy gave the Treasurer's Report for Janna Buhler. She reported we have \$43,632.00 in savings and \$3,225.80 in checking for a combined available balance of \$46,857.80. Tammy reported a copy of the Treasurer's Report is available in the school office for review. Tammy asked for a motion to approve the treasurer's report. Leslie Wiegler made a motion to approve the report; Ashley Harrell seconded the motion. The motion was passed.

Tammy next reported on fundraising. We raised more than \$16,000 with the Olympian Fund campaign. Tammy thanked everyone for their support. The monies raised will cover our budget for the year with some surplus.

Next, Tammy explained to the assembly that PTA Vice-President Patsy Brinson accepted a job with Eaton Afterschool in October. As a school employee, she is no longer eligible to serve on the PTA Board. Upon her resignation, the Executive Board nominated Ashley Harrell for Vice-President with a majority vote. Ashley accepted the nomination, and is now our new VP. Tammy introduced Ashley Harrell to the General Assembly.

Tammy introduced Leslie Wiegler to discuss Operation Holiday Cheer. Leslie explained that 3rd Grade teacher Heather Glover's husband was injured while serving in Afghanistan. Parents in her classroom wanted to do something to help. Leslie explained the parents decided to honor Captain Glover by sending support locally to the marines. The class is collecting money to buy items for care packages or stockings that will be distributed to marines. Donations can be sent in with your children. All the money collected will go to this project.

Next, Ms. Carroll reminded everyone that Lost & Found items are displayed in the Media Center. She encouraged parents to look through and claim items tonight, as all items will be sent to Goodwill tomorrow.

Tammy adjourned the General Assembly meeting at 6:36 and turned the meeting over to Mrs. Kanzler for the Winter Chorus performance.
